ORDINANCE #4

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL HAND GUNS IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS IN THE TOWN OF CLEARFIELD

The Town Board of the Town of Clearfield, Juneau County, Wisconsin, do ordain, as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS: As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(a) **"Public Building"** means any structure, including exterior platform or steps providing means of ingress or egress, used in whole or in part as a place of resort, assemblage, lodging, trade, traffic, occupancy or use by the public.

(b) **"Hand Gun"** means any weapon designed or redesigned, or made or remade, and intended to be fired while held in one hand and to use the energy of an explosive, gas or air to expell a projectile through a smooth or rifled bore.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to wear or carry a hand gun in any building open for business to the public, except for said persons place of lodging, in the Town of Clearfield, unless the person is:

(a) A law enforcement officer;

(b) A licensed gun dealer at his place of business;

(c) In a licensed gun dealer's place of business for the purpose of buying or selling a hand gun, or delivering or picking up a hand gun for repairs.

(d) In his own place of business, or a place of business of a partnership or corporation of which he is a part owner or principal stockholder.

SECTION 3. Any person found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, together with the costs of such proceedings and upon his failure to pay such forfeiture and costs, may be imprisoned in the County Jail of Juneau County until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4. If any Section or part of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
